Background

Faith Community Church (FCC) is an intentional disciple-making church, committed to love God passionately and love people practically. Our vision is to see people saved, churches revived and nations transformed.

About the role

FCC is looking for 1 full time Youth Pastor to join the staff team. Kinetic is the name of our Youth Ministry at Faith Community Church, led by a team of staff and volunteers whose passion is youths and whose vision is to see every high school student connected to Christ. Our goal is to give every high schooler a place to belong, no matter the school or year group. We believe that our faith drives us to love and care for others, and we want everyone to be a part of it! The full-time Youth Pastor will helm the Kinetic Lead team and ensure that Kinetic Service Nights and Connect Groups offer a home for Youths to experience God and community each week.

The Youth Pastor will be required to:

- Lead Kinetic in alignment with FCC's vision and seasonal focus
- Be responsible for pastoral leadership and discipleship of Kinetic youths
- Recruit, raise, and retain volunteer leaders
- Develop and oversee execution of Kinetic services, connect groups, and annual camps
- Work with other Next Gen, Connect ministries and parents to holistically disciple youths
- Serve as key liaison for Kinetic to other ministries, where applicable

Selection Criteria

- A deep passion for God and youths
- Experience leading youths or young people is a must
- Friday nights and weekend Sundays required
- Demonstrated ability to preach, teach, and lead leaders
- Ability to relate well cross-culturally and intergenerationally
- A flexible approach to changing priorities and duties
- An understanding of Faith Community Church and its culture and values

- Be a self-starter and team builder. Thrive in a team environment, working well in a multigenerational and multi-department staff team
- A theological degree or equivalent years of ministry experience preferred

Application process

Please submit an application which clearly addresses the following:

- Provide a cover letter outlining your suitability in relation to the selection criteria;
- A copy of your resume including your educational qualifications relevant to the duties, employment history, as well as the name and contact of 2 professional referees (a maximum of 3 pages);
- Evidence of Australian Citizenship or Permanent Residency.

Pre-employment checks in the form of a National Police Clearance and Working With Children Check will apply.
