

## ALEXANDER STREET (ProQuest) – Digital Library of Classical Protestant

The Digital Library of Classical Protestant is a collection of seminal works from the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> centuries – the Reformation and post-Reformation eras. The collection includes sermons, lectures, letters, commentaries and orations by prominent leaders of the Reformation period from Western Europe including Luther, Calvin, Zwingli, Tyndale, Melanchthon, Beza, Bucer, Bullinger, Chemnitz, Cranmer, Arminius and many others who have shaped and defined the Lutheran, Reformed, Anglican, Presbyterian, Baptist, Anabaptist, Puritan, and Congregationalist traditions – or the Protestant Reformation.

The platform has moved to a newly enhanced Alexander Street LAZR platform. The modernized interface will consider the devices users are accessing the platform with, and the display will match it (large monitors, standard desktops, laptops, tablets and smart phones).
