Mission

Lakeside exists to Encourage, Equip and Empower people to say "yes" to Jesus.

Position Description: Children Pastor

Hours: 3 days per week (0.6FTE)

Days: Mondays, Sunday AM – other hours to be negotiated.

Reporting to: Senior Pastor.

Scope: Lakeside Kidz includes programmes for crèche age children and all primary age children. The main areas inside Lakeside Kidz are:

- <u>Sunday Kidz.</u> Church-based program (Sunday School) consisting of approximately 100 children over four age-appropriate programs. Sunday Kidz has roughly 30 volunteers serving.
- 2- <u>Wildside</u>. This is a fortnightly Saturday night primary aged (yr 4 yr6) youth group(Middle Ground Program).
- 3- <u>Toddler Jam</u>. Is a weekly music based program for pre-school aged children and their carers. This is a community outreach program with up to 30 children per session and volunteer helpers.
- 4- <u>Rec Centre Ministry</u>. The Children's ministry also engages in the Rec Centre through different events, being actively visible and creating outreach opportunities.
- 5- <u>Participate in the General Life of the Church</u>. As with all ministry areas, children's ministry is a part of the Church's broader life and therefore does not operate in and of itself.

Responsibilities and duties

- 1- Create environments, activities and programming for each age group that will allow children to explore their faith and grow in their spiritual development.
- 2- To develop and oversee a Ministry team who work together to build the Children's ministry and provide support for the Children's Pastor.
- 3- The Children's Pastor is responsible for all children's ministry before High School and to ensure all activities programmed are adequately planned and staffed.
 - a. Choose and prepare curriculum for each program and each age level. Continue to deliver an engaging and creative program, exploring the Christian faith and Word of God.

- b. Recruit, train, schedule and lead teams of volunteers.
- 4- Create and maintain a vision for the children's ministry and promote to the wider Church.
- 5- To provide pastoral care for children and families within the Church.
- 6- Explore and implement ways of linking with Recreation Centre staff and programs, creating ministry opportunities with children and families.
- 7- To see that everyone in the Children's Ministry meets or obtains all Lakeside Safe Church requirements.
 - a. To ensure safety issues are carefully considered, and appropriate risk minimisation procedures are implemented and maintained
- 8- To regularly evaluate the effectiveness of the Children's Ministry.
- 9- To engage in the wider life and leadership of the Church.

Selection Criteria – Please address each one

- 1. Have proven success in children's ministry.
- 2. Demonstrated passion for the spiritual / pastoral needs of children.
- 3. Ability to engage and manage groups of children.
- 4. Proven capacity to develop and lead a team to inspire, train and lead others.
- 5. Excellent communication, organisation and administration skills.
- 6. Understanding of complex needs that children may have, affecting their ability to engage in ministry activities.
- 7. Ability to plan and implement appropriate curriculum and ministry experiences for children.
- 8. Relevant educational/theological qualifications and experience
