We are looking for someone to join us full time on the senior staff at St Matthew's, whose primary responsibility will be our 11am Family congregation. As with all ministries at St Matthew's the role is to lead a team. To disciple, train, and grow the existing 11am leadership team, as they disciple, train, and grow others.

We are seeking a theologically qualified person who shares our theology, values, and culture to lead this vital ministry. The 11am pastor will report directly to the Senior Minister of St Matthew's.

The Responsibilities

- Overall oversight and leadership of 11am, in line with our mission including:
 - Regularly preaching at 11am and across St Matthew's generally.
 - Recruitment, discipleship and training of leaders.
 - Formulating ministry strategy and plans in consultation with the rest of the St Matthew's team.
- As a member of the St Matthew's team, other responsibilities depending on the needs of the parish and the gifts and interests of the successful applicant.

The Person

- A vital personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ, seeking to live in obedience to his expressed will in the written word of God.
- Commitment to the mission of St Matthew's church and in full agreement with our doctrinal statement.
- Capable preacher and teacher of God's word committed to expository and exegetical preaching.
- Commitment to Christ-centered, Bible-based ministry.
- Minimum of a 3 year BTh or MDiv qualification.
- Ability to be a team leader.
- Ability to foster and model godly relationships with believers and unbelievers, colleagues and neighbours.
- Willingness to continue to grow as a pastor and be involved in ongoing training.
- Communicant member of the Anglican Church of Australia (or willing to become one). Ordination in the Anglican Church of Australia is not required.

Remuneration

Remuneration package is based on the Diocese of Perth clergy stipends and allowances schedule and rated on qualifications and experience. It includes generous options for salary packaging and includes a housing allowance.
