Our mission at St Matthew's is "Making Disciples Together" (Matt 28:18-20). We long to see a flood of new, lifelong disciples of Jesus Christ in our Church, all building each other up in maturity and the fullness of Christ (Eph 4:11-13).

We are looking for someone to join us full time on the senior staff at St Matthew's, whose primary responsibility will be to disciple, train, and grow Women across St Matthew's, as they in turn disciple, train, and grow others.

We are seeking a theologically qualified person who shares our theology, values, and culture to lead this vital ministry. The Women's Trainer will report directly to the Senior Minister of St Matthew's.

The Responsibilities

- Training women to be leaders across St Matthew's including:
 - Recruitment, discipleship, and training of women leaders.
 - Raising up teams for each of our congregations who will lead the women's ministry within each congregation.
 - Training our women ministry apprentices.
- Being part of other mixed gender leadership and discipleship training across St Matthew's (e.g. small group leaders, ministry apprentices etc).
- As a member of the St Matthew's team other responsibilities depending on the needs of the parish and the gifts and interests of the successful applicant.

The Person

- A vital personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ, seeking to live in obedience to his expressed will in the written word of God.
- Commitment to the mission of St Matthew's church and in full agreement with our doctrinal statement.
- Capable teacher of God's word committed to expository and exegetical preaching.
- Commitment to Christ-centered, Bible-based ministry.
- Minimum of a 3 year BTh or MDiv qualification.
- Ability to be a team leader.
- Ability to foster and model godly relationships with believers and unbelievers, colleagues and neighbours.
- Willingness to continue to grow as a leader/trainer and be involved in ongoing professional development.
- Communicant member of the Anglican Church of Australia (or willing to become one). Ordination in the Anglican Church of Australia is not required.
- Applicant must pass all required police and Working with Children checks.

Remuneration

Remuneration package is based on the Diocese of Perth clergy stipends and allowances schedule and rated on qualifications and experience. It includes generous options for salary packaging and includes a housing allowance.
