According to the 2021 Census of the Shire of Narrogin:

38% of people have more than a Year 12 education.

30% have at least one parent born overseas.

178 people identify as being Baptist.

50% of population identify as No Religion.

58% people work full-time, and 31% work part time.

Median weekly incomes per household are \$1310.

18% households are single parents, with 80% of them being women.

Selection Criteria

The ideal applicant would have the following Qualities:

- 7) Compliance with Safe Church and Working with Children's Card requirements for a Pastor within the Baptist Union of Western Australia.
