Who We Need

The successful applicant will be a committed Christian who possesses the ability to relate warmly with others (particularly children).

About the Role

The Crèche Assistant will help with:

- Supervising children one morning a week during semester, ensuring the physical, mental, and emotional safety of children that attend
- o Providing children with guidance towards appropriate behaviour and positive social interaction
- Setting up and packing up
- Providing basic First Aid, if necessary

They will also provide coverage in the event that the Crèche Coordinator is unavailable (at an increased rate of pay).

Trinity is committed to providing a safe and secure environment, particularly for Children and Vulnerable People. All employees are required to undergo regular training in Safe Ministry Conduct and adhere to its standards.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Be a committed Christian who supports the mission, vision, and ethos of Trinity
- 2. Experience in supervising children of different age groups
- 3. Warm and positive person able to interact well with, and be sensitive to the needs of, people from a range of different backgrounds
- 4. Ability to be firm and provide confident direction to people of all ages
- 5. Committed to upholding high standards of safety and care of children, including undergoing annual training and reporting any signs of abuse

Qualifications

Essential

1. Ability to obtain or possession of a Working with Children Check

Desirable

- 1. Ability to obtain or possession of a current First Aid qualification which includes providing CPR, asthma and anaphylaxis management
- 2. Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care, or equivalent

- Pay rate based on the Educational Services (Post-Secondary Education) Award, Level 1, plus 11% superannuation
