### Female Youth and Young Adults Leader

#### **Role Overview**

The Youth and Young Adults Leader will assist in developing programs, building relationships, and providing missional discipleship opportunities for youth and young adults aged 12–25. This Christ-centered role supports Carey's youth and young adults ministry by fostering spiritual growth with a focus on the Great Commission.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

##### 1. Discipleship and Mentoring

- Foster relationships with young people, guided by Scripture and the Holy Spirit.
- Support, mentor and train youth and young adult leaders in their faith and roles.

##### 2. Program Support

- Partner with the Youth and Young Adults Pastor to guide and support our ministries.
- Assist in implementing engaging and effective ministry programs.

##### 3. Community Engagement

- Cultivate an inclusive, welcoming environment reflecting Carey Church's Gospel values.
- Liaise with parents, schools, and Baptists Churches WA to holistically support young people.

##### 4. Administrative Duties

- Maintain attendance records and assist with budgets and communications.

- Work collaboratively with staff and volunteers for smooth ministry operations.

### **Required Skills and Attributes**

- A growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Passion for and understanding of youth and young adults' unique needs.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Ability to collaborate within a team.
- Attention to detail and organizational skills.
- Alignment with Carey Church's mission and values.
- Commitment to Sunday mornings and Friday night youth ministry.

- Experience in youth or young adult ministry (volunteer or paid).
- Theological training or willingness to pursue it (desirable).
