

- 3. Identify 2 areas in which you feel you may need additional support or development if you were to get the role of Associate Pastor at BBC.
- 4. Provide insight into your personal life purpose as a Christian and how being an Associate Pastor in Byford would fit into God's plan for your life.
- 5. Share your doctrinal position and how this shapes your ministry and life.



Byford Baptist Church is a medium sized Baptist Church located in Jarrahdale–Serpentine, Byford, Western Australia.

The church was formed in 1975 and is a member church of Baptist Churches Western Australia (BCWA). We have a current membership of 51, and a regular attendance of 80-100 people at our Sunday services.

We are a family friendly church who are seeking to share the transforming love and gospel of Jesus with our community.



The Associate Pastor Purpose:

To assist the Lead Pastor in pastoral care and general oversight of Byford Baptist Church with a main focus on ministry development, training and discipleship. This is in line with our mission, specifically for the area of equipping our church to share and model their faith as well as serving each other and the community.

Role Description:


- Oversight and development of current inner church ministries such as Next Gen Ministries (Creche, Junior church & Youth), Young Adults and Growth Groups.
- Working with the Lead Pastor and Community Pastor to create new ministry and discipleship opportunities and events for the ongoing growth and health of the church.
- Recruiting and equipping volunteers to effectively and confidently serve in their various ministries.
- · Occasional Preaching on Sundays

Requirements for the role:

- A committed Christian who has been baptised by full immersion as a believer in Christ.
- A bachelor's degree, or equivalent level of theological/ministry education.
- Experience in leadership in a local church or mission, with strong admin skills to be able to develop leaders and ministry areas.
- Acceptance and agreement with the Constitution of BBC.
- Willing, as a family (if applicable) to live in Byford or suburb within easy commute.

Key Attributes We Are Looking For

- A Word-based faith as the ultimate authority.
- A desire to seek God earnestly and live out an authentic faith through His Spirit.
- A pastoral heart marked by love, mercy and servant leadership.
- The ability to communicate doctrinally sound biblical teaching for discipleship and life transformation.
- Enthusiasm for sharing the gospel with people of all ages and backgrounds.
- Passion for the wider community and encouraging new faith connections.



Employment Terms and Conditions

Employment Terms

The position offered is a permanent full-time position based on 40 hours per week. The church recognises that a Pastor's role requires an often-irregular investment of time, including working outside normal 'office hours' due to evening meetings, and on weekends, so the church encourages taking time off in lieu where appropriate.

The initial contract will be for 3 years with the possibility of renewal afterwards. The appointee will consent to BBC's Doctrinal Basis as well as the BUWA Code of Ethics.

Stipend/Wages

Stipend payment will be made fortnightly.

The pay for the Associate Pastor will be the recommended rate as specified by BCWA for local appointments.

Superannuation

BBC will make the Superannuation Guarantee contribution as per ATO guidelines.

Annual Leave and Sick Leave

Annual leave and sick leave will be accrued in accordance with the Fair Work Award Guidelines.
